Since our inception in May 2021, to establish the QMC as a trusted advocate for motorcyclists in Queensland, we:

- Have received funding in 2024 from Ride to Zero Grant for 100 subsidised participants in post-QRide "Keep It Upright" training courses;
- Have received funding in 2025 from Ride to Zero Grant for 100 subsidised participants in post-QRide "Roadcraft", "Cornering and Braking" and "Slow Moves and Pillioning" training courses;
- Have become an active participant as a member of the Queensland Road Safety Stakeholder Partnering Group;
- Are an active participant in a number of road safety workshops and focus groups as a representative of the motorcycle community in Queensland;
- Are an active participant in the Connected Vehicles Initiative;
- Are a regular attendee at a range of road safety events.

- Were an invited attendee of the Minister for Transport and Main Roads Road Safety Roundtable;
